## HOW TO GET YOUR HEALING



There are many scriptures in the Bible on the subject of healing. So many, in fact, that one would have to choose to ignore their meaning and import in order to not believe in healing today. It is not my purpose here to look at every scripture concerning healing, nor to convince the reader of healing. I am, instead, assuming that because you are reading this pamphlet, you believe in healing for today. So let's get started getting you well! I am going to list fourteen (14) things you must consider about getting healed, whether you have a cold or something worse.

**1. Read over many, many times and meditate constantly on Isaiah 53: 1-5.** Please make special note that the word "griefs" in verse 4 is the Hebrew for "physical sickness" – *always, in every case.*

The bottom line of all healing is "*Who has believed our (God's) report?*" There are other reports: doctors, family, genetics, history, etc.

If you are not willing to read many times and meditate constantly on the healing that God affords, if you are not willing to get hold of and hang on to this truth, then there is no need for you to read further. Don't waste your time with this pamphlet. Instead, prepare to get worse; that is the general course of things.

Proverbs 4:20-22 – "My son, *attend* to my words; *incline* thine ear unto my sayings. *Let them not depart* from thine eyes; *keep* them in the midst of thine heart. For they *are* life unto those that *find* them, and *health* to all their flesh." (italics, mine)

**2.** Know this: The problem **never** lies at God's doorstep. He has always been very plain about your healing. **He always, in every case, wants you healed.** That is one of the reasons why He sent Jesus to earth. "By his stripes, we are healed." So don't blame God or question his intent. His will on the matter is quite plain and open. If you don't know it, it is because you haven't read his will (his word). "*Who has believed our report!*"

**3. Don't get down on yourself!** That will only hasten your death. You are your only hope, so don't cut yourself off. *It is seldom a lack of faith on your part!!* The Bible says very plainly that He (God) has dealt to all men the measure of faith. If you are not saved, get saved, and you will have the measure of faith.

The problem could be undeveloped faith (develop it), unused faith (use it), lack of knowledge (read and learn), unforgiveness (forgive), sin (repent), etc. So you can see that if healing is not working, there is something you can do about it. The woman said, "I will touch his robe." Zacchaeus said, "I will return all I have stolen."

**4. Never wonder "why?" or "what am I doing wrong?"** To question "why?" is to find fault with God. Don't alienate the One who has the power to heal. You are saved, and Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice." So if you are doing something wrong, God can get your attention and show you what more to do, or do differently. Just read his word, meditate, and continue to stand. Trust him and don't pick and pry.

**5. Get settled in your mind the difference between healing and manifestation.** Healing was secured for you on Calvary. Jesus said, "It (the work the Father sent me to do – which includes healing) is finished (accomplished)." God can't heal you, because He already has. The manifestation of that healing hasn't shown up just yet. If you put a drop of blue food coloring in a glass of clear water, it will take just seconds for all the water to

turn blue. Yet you know in your mind the minute you drop it in, the water is blue. A little apple tree will someday produce apples; and if you water it and help it along, someday you will have apples. But remember, it is an apple tree and it has the ability to produce apples, they just haven't yet manifested. (Now, re-read Proverbs 4:20-22.)

**6.** Never, never say, "I am being healed" or "I am going to be healed." You *are* healed. You must say what **God** says, if the manifestation is going to be yours. So say, **"I am healed."** **"By his stripes, I am healed."** That is not a lie, an exaggeration, or a hopeful statement. It is God's word, and He cannot lie.

**7.** **Determine you are not going to be moved by what you feel or see!** Paul said, "We walk by faith and not by sight." Faith has nothing to do with sight or feelings. In fact, sight and feelings will destroy your faith, if you let them. But faith will take sight and feelings and replace them with truth, if you let it. *"Who has believed our (God's) report!"*

Unless you are miraculously and immediately healed, you will most probably have some pain, weight loss, physical deficiencies, etc., *until* the manifestation begins to show up. To emphasize these things will stop faith, or faith will make these things give way to victory.

**8.** **Don't get under condemnation if your mind starts to doubt.** Make sure your *heart* doesn't doubt. Mark 11:23 – "Whosoever shall say unto this mountain, be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt *in his heart*, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith." (italics, mine)

How do you keep your heart from doubting? Feed it faith food! Read Proverbs 4: 20-22 again.

**9.** **Guard your words!!** If you are going to talk the way the world talks, you won't get healed. People die of cancer, heart ailment, disease, etc., every day. And the one thing about them all is that they are saying the same things. If you want God's word to work in your life, then you must speak God's word. Be very careful what comes out of your mouth. The angels are listening for God's word to perform it (Psalm 103:20), and the devil is listening to see if he is having an effect on you. The devil is not omniscient or omnipresent, so he depends on hearing what you are saying to know if he is having any effect on you.

**10.** When people tell you how you look, just say, "Don't look." **Keep pictures of yourself before you got sick beside all your mirrors.** When you look into the mirror, tell the mirror it is a liar. Point to the picture and say, "This is the truth." *"Who has believed our report!"*

**11.** **Act like you are healed.** If you say you are healed, and you act like you are not, *then* you are a liar. Sick people stay in bed, well people get up and get going. Sick people walk around in pajamas, well people get dressed and get out of the house. See the idea? Show the Lord you believe his word. He says you are healed, you say you believe that, so act like you do. Actions speak louder than words. *"Who has believed our report!"*

**12.** **Stay with God's word!** Let it form your words and your actions. Don't interpret God's word to fit your experience. Make your experience fit God's word. His word never changes, your experiences can and do. The word says, "I shall not die, but live...", not "I shall live and not die..." (There is a great difference there, if you think about it.) Be true with God's word!

**13.** Don't fall into the trap of saying, "God is going to get (or is getting) the glory out of all of this." That is not true. If you died as a Christian with a smile on your face without complaining, God would get some glory. But the devil will get the rest because his sickness killed you. And know this: *God will not share his glory with anyone!* The only way for God to get the glory, all the glory, is for you to get the manifestation of your healing. So buckle down and get busy grabbing that manifestation and holding on to it.

**14.** All that I have told you is going to take work—the hardest work you have ever, ever done. Your friends are going to tell you all kinds of horror stories, they are going to make fun of you. Your family is going to feel sorry for you and hurt for you and cry over you. The religious world is going to laugh at you and make fun of you. And your own body is going to hurt so bad that you just want to give up. *But if you do*, you won't have victory. If that is what you want, then don't waste your time 'trying' to get healed. Just go ahead and quit. You can go to Heaven because you are saved. You will wind up defeated, and your family and loved ones will be bereft of your presence. Your little children won't understand, and they could blame God and learn to hate Him – but you will be in Heaven.

However, the Bible says, "**Fight the good fight of faith.**" Don't fight the sickness, don't fight the devil. Your fight is to stay in faith at all times. That is the only fight you ever have to fight – the fight to stay in faith and out of doubt.

(Note: These principles will work for financial difficulties, as well!)
